DAME ALICE HUDSON

Dame Alice is the inaugural Executive Head Teacher of the Twyford Church of England Academies Trust set up in October 2011, in order to allow the diocese to use the strengths built up at Twyford CofE High School to be developed beyond a single school.

Alice was made a Dame Commander of the Order of the British Empire (DBE) in the Queen's 2016 90th Birthday Honours for services to Education and received special mention in the official Cabinet Office press release;[2] the citation for her award recognised her consistent work to improve educational standards in a career spanning over 30 years.

Last February Twyford High school has been designated Teaching School Hub for the region covering Hounslow, Ealing, Harrow and Hillingdon.



VIV GRANT

Viv has been in the education profession for over thirty years. She is a former primary Headteacher and over twenty years ago was one of the youngest Heads in the country to turn around a failing primary school.

She has been a lead trainer and consultant for a number of educational training bodies, including the Department for Education, the National College, The London Centre for Leadership in Learning at the Institute of Education and the NUT. Viv was a contributing author to the 2011 publication "Mentoring and Coaching in Schools" and in 2014, she published her first book, "Staying A Head: The Stress Management Secrets of Successful School Leaders." Viv has written for the Guardian and appeared on TV, BBC Radio London and BBC Radio 4 Woman's hour, talking about her work and the role coaching plays in helping school leaders to excel.



Colin has worked at five large comprehensive schools as a language's teacher, head of department and faculty, deputy head and finally headteacher. He was also a senior adviser in the National Strategies in the data and evaluation team. He joined SSAT in 2011 and is currently a senior education lead with responsibility for data, accountability, and inspection.
